3. Any party wishing to respond to Ameren Missouri's Motion in Limine or to Strike Testimony shall do so no later than January 2, 2015.

4. Any party wishing to respond to Public Counsel's Motion in Limine or to Exclude Portions of the Testimony of Staff Witness John Rogers and Ameren Missouri's Witness Richard Voytas shall do so no later than January 2, 2015.
