ORDER CLOSING FILE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the request of Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and KCPL Greater Missouri Operations ("GMO") to cease the filing of quarterly updates and close this file ("motion").¹

The Commission opened this file when the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC") filed a *Motion to Open Investigation*,² alleging safety issues related to a new transmission line. The Commission ordered monitoring and continued public discussion, and ordered periodic reporting by KCP&L and GMO.³

Those orders are no longer necessary, the motion argues, alleging that the construction is complete and the line is energized. No party filed a response to the motion within the time allowed by regulation.⁴ Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion and close this file.
