CORRECTION TO STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION TO ISSUE DEPRECIATION AUTHORITY ORDER AND ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY ORDER

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), by and through Counsel, and for its Corrected Recommendation states:

- 1. In its Recommendation filed May 30, 2012, Staff inadvertently referred to Account 246 with regard to the recommended depreciation authority order. That reference should have been to Account 346.
- 2. As corrected, Staff's recommendation is that the Commission issue a Depreciation Authority Order (DAO) and an Accounting Authority Order (AAO) including the following:
 - An AAO providing for an amortization period of 47.7 years for accounts 30310 for both KCPL and GMO, resulting in a 2.10% annual accrual. This account consists of the respective portions of the total project cost of the replacement of the HWY 45/273 bridge over a railroad, including both construction of the new bridge and the removal cost of the old bridge. This does not include projected cost of removal for the new bridge.
 - A DAO setting a depreciation rate of 2.27% for KCPL account 346, Other Production – Miscellaneous Power Plant Equipment. This account includes various pieces of equipment not properly assignable to other specified accounts.

WHEREFORE, Staff requests that the Commission accept its Corrected Recommendation.
