ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

On May 11, 2009, the Commission issued an order which, among other things, directed KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO), along with its joint signatories, to file a stipulation and agreement memorializing any settled issues in this matter no later than May 15, 2009. On that date, the Staff of the Commission and GMO filed a joint motion for additional time.

Staff and GMO state that while progress has been made and GMO has provided tariff sheets it believes comport with the settlement principles, Staff anticipates that it will not be able to complete its review before Tuesday, May 19, 2009, and that other joint signatories will not complete their review until sometime thereafter. Further, discussion and review of certain other provisions of the agreement is still ongoing. Staff and GMO therefore request the Commission to extend the date for filing the stipulation and agreement to May 22, 2009, and extend the date for any nonsignatories to object to May 29, 2009.

The Commission has reviewed the joint motion and will grant the requested extensions.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Joint Motion for Additional Time to File Stipulation and Agreement is granted.

2. No later than May 22, 2009, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, along with its joint signatories, shall file a stipulation and agreement memorializing any settled issues in this matter and the terms of the settlement.

3. Any party wishing to file a response or to request an evidentiary hearing with respect to any issue in this matter to the stipulation and agreement shall file such response no later than May 29, 2009.

4. This order is effective upon issuance.
