ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE OF KCPL AND EMPIRE

On November 1, 2007, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed an application seeking authority to continue the control of its transmission system by the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO). The Commission provided notice of the filing to potentially interested parties and established November 30 as an intervention deadline.

Kansas City Power & Light Company applied to intervene on November 26. The Empire District Electric Company applied to intervene on November 30. No party has objected to either application to intervene.

The Commission finds that the interests of KCPL and Empire in this case are different from those of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing KCPL and Empire to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

- 1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's Application to Intervene is granted.
- 2. The Empire District Electric Company's Application to Intervene is granted.
- 3. This order shall become effective on December 11, 2007.
