On January 4, 2008, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed an application for the opening of a proceeding to receive its status report on wind investments. KCPL filed the status report pursuant to its Regulatory Plan approved by the Commission in Case No. EO-2005-0329. The status report stated that “KCPL concluded that it would not be prudent to proceed with the additional 100 MW of wind generation for completion in 2008”¹ that was originally contemplated in Section 4 of the Stipulation and Agreement in Case No. EO-2005-0329.

The Commission finds that notice of the status report shall be given to the parties to Case No. EO-2005-0329. The Commission will set an intervention deadline and a date for the filing of the Staff’s recommendation and any other response to the status report.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall serve a copy of this order on all parties to Case No. EO-2005-0329, concerning Kansas City Power & Light Company’s Regulatory Plan.

3. The Staff of the Commission shall file either its recommendation or a status report stating the earliest date on which it intends to file its recommendation concerning Kansas City Power & Light Company's status report on wind investments, no later than February 19, 2008.

4. Any other party wishing to respond to Kansas City Power & Light Company's status report on wind investments shall file its response no later than February 19, 2008.

5. This order shall become effective on January 14, 2008.
