On November 19, 2008, the Staff of the Commission filed a request to suspend the procedural schedule filing date in this case to December 19, 2008, to allow Staff, Kansas City Power & Light Company, and the Office of the Public Counsel time to determine if all issues can be resolved by a unanimous stipulation and agreement. KCPL and Public Counsel concur in this request. If the parties are unable to reach a resolution by December 19, Staff will file either an update on progress toward a stipulation or its recommendation and a proposed procedural schedule.

The Commission has considered Staff's request and shall grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff Request for Suspension of Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. No later than December 19, 2008, the Commission's Staff shall file a unanimous stipulation and agreement, an update on progress toward a stipulation, or its recommendation and a proposed procedural schedule.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
