- 1. Staff proposes to amend rules 4 CSR 240-3.530 and 4 CSR 240-3.535. These rules currently set forth the filing requirements for a telecommunications company seeking Commission authority to issue stock, bonds, notes and other evidences of indebtedness (4 CSR 240-3.530) or to acquire the stock of a public utility (4 CSR 240-3.535). This proposed rulemaking removes the current exemptions for competitive companies. The proposed amendments are necessary to ensure the Commission has a complete application and financial information when considering stock transactions. The proposed amendment will also require the company to provide reasons as to why the transaction is not detrimental to the public, thus assisting the Commission in its review of the public interest standards.
- 2. Staff proposes to initiate a new rulemaking, 4 CSR 240-3.560, to outline procedures a telecommunications company must follow when ceasing operation in Missouri, or discontinuing service to a geographic area within the state. Currently, there are no requirements for companies to notify the Commission when ceasing operation or discontinuing service to Missouri customers.

3 Staff proposes to initiate a new rulemaking, 4 CSR 240-3.565, to outline procedures a certificated telecommunications company must follow when notifying the Commission of its or its affiliate's bankruptcy filings. The proposed rule requires telecommunications companies to notify the Commission of the bankruptcy filing, case number, filing date, bankruptcy court, etc. The proposed rule also requires telecommunications companies to provide the Commission with a copy of any order from
