MOTION TO CORRECT ORDER

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Motion to Correct Order* states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On February 19, 2008, the Commission entered its *Order Denying Motion to Reject, and Approving Tariff to Adjust Rate Schedules for Fuel Adjustment Clause*.

2. The first paragraph there-in refers to KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) as “Kansas City Power and Light Greater Missouri Operations Company.”

3. The second ordered paragraph there-in refers to “Kansas City Power & Light Greater Missouri Operations Company.”

4. Staff respectfully requests correction of both cited references to read “KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company,” which is the name under which the Missouri Secretary of State has authorized the Company to do business in this state; and furthermore, is the name under which the Commission has authorized the Company to operate as a public utility in this state, by *Report and Order* effective December 3, 2008 in Case No. EN-2009-0164.

5. According to the Missouri Secretary of State’s website, neither “Kansas City Power & Light Greater Missouri Operations Company,” nor “Kansas City Power and Light Greater Missouri Operations Company,” are authorized by the Missouri Secretary of State to do business within the State of Missouri.

6. Neither “Kansas City Power & Light Greater Missouri Operations Company,” nor “Kansas City Power and Light Greater Missouri Operations Company,” are authorized by this Commission to do business within the State of Missouri as a public utility.

7. The tariff sheet GMO filed as Schedule TMR-1 to the Direct Filing of Tim M. Rush in GMO’s December 30, 2008 direct filing in this matter may have contributed to the name confusion. That tariff sheet shows the company name to be “Kansas City Power & Light Greater Missouri Operations Company.”

8. On January 22, 2008, GMO filed a revised tariff sheet. In an attached letter, GMO indicated that the purpose for the revision was to reflect the inclusion of what it described as costs inadvertently omitted from its initial filing. GMO also showed the company’s name as “KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company” on that revised tariff sheet.

9. The corrected tariff sheet filed by the Company on January 23, 2008, which is the specimen recommended for approval by the Staff, and approved by the Commission’s February 19, 2009 *Order*, also refers to “KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company.”

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission correct its *Order Denying Motion to Reject, and Approving Tariff to Adjust Rate Schedules for Fuel Adjustment Clause*, to correct the references to “Kansas City Power & Light Greater Missouri Operations Company” and “Kansas City Power and Light Greater Missouri Operations Company,” found therein to “KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company.”
