## **NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF ELECTRIC SUPPLIER, ORDER ADDING PARTIES, AND ORDER DIRECTING FILINGS**

On August 4, 2009, Harold and Debbie Meyer filed an application to change their electric supplier from the City of Marceline, Missouri, to Macon Electric Cooperative. The request is for electricity supplied to the Applicants' residence at 902 South Fairview Drive, Marceline, Missouri. The Applicants state that the Cooperative is willing to provide service but that the City of Marceline has refused to allow the change of supplier.

The Commission determines that the City and the Cooperative should be added as necessary parties to this matter and will direct that notice of the application be sent to them. The Commission will also set a time for responses to the application.

The Commission would be aided by a recommendation from its Staff. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to file either a recommendation or a status report indicating when it expects to file a recommendation as directed below.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The City of Marceline, Missouri, and Macon Electric Cooperative are added as parties to this case.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this notice to the City of Marceline, Missouri, and to Macon Electric Cooperative.

3. Any responses to this application shall be filed no later than September 8, 2009.
4. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation or a status report no later than September 18, 2009.
5. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
