NOTICE REGARDING REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF DATE AND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

Date Issued: October 7, 2009

On August 20, 2009, after the KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed the application as described above, the Commission directed the Staff of the Commission to file a pleading informing the Commission of a date by which Staff would file a recommendation. The order was primarily driven by KCP&L's requests that the Commission issue an order approving the application no later than October 13.

Staff filed its pleading informing the Commission that it would file a recommendation no later than October 6. On October 2, however, the company requested that the date by which the Commission issues its order be extended to December 13. Staff, then, filed a motion for an extension of time to file its recommendation.

The Commission notes that there has been no order directing Staff to file its recommendation on a specific date. Staff has simply informed the Commission of a date by which it would file its recommendation and now, through motion, informed the Commission that the date has changed. The Commission therefore need not grant Staff's motion. Likewise, the company has requested that the Commission issue an order by a certain date and has now extended the date by which the company seeks a Commission order. The company need not request that the date be extended.

The parties appear to be on one accord and are working together to secure the relief KCP&L requests. However, in order for the Commission to issue an order by December 13th, it must be placed on the December 9th Agenda. Because the Commission will require time to review the order prior to Agenda, an order will not be issued on December 9th if Staff files its recommendation on December 7th. Therefore, if the parties seek an order from the Commission by December 13th, Staff must file its recommendation prior to December 7th.
