**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO POSTPONE FILING DATE**  
**FOR PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On December 21, 2007, the Joint Applicants, Great Plains Energy Incorporated, Kansas City Power & Light Company, and Aquila, Inc., filed a motion requesting that the filing of a proposed procedural schedule be postponed. Applicants relate that during the recent settlement conference, the parties concluded that it would be preferable to delay the filing of a proposed schedule pending additional discussions. Applicants intend to meet with the parties during the week of January 7, 2008, to explain their revised regulatory plan, and intend to provide their proposal to the parties prior to that meeting. Applicants are hopeful that the revised plan will be the basis for possible settlement of the case, and therefore request that the Commission postpone the filing of a proposed procedural schedule until the parties have had additional time to discuss possible resolution of the issues.

The Commission has considered the motion and finds that it is reasonable to delay the filing of a proposed procedural schedule as the Joint Applicants request.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. No later than January 15, 2008, the parties shall separately or jointly file their proposed procedural schedule(s) for the remainder of this case.
2. This order shall become effective on December 21, 2007.
