**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO ADVISE COMMISSION IF NEW TARIFF
FILINGS ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH REPORT AND ORDER**

On January 11, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued its Report and Order in this matter approving The Empire District Electric Company's ("Empire") and White River Valley Electric Cooperative's territorial agreement. In the Report and Order, the Commission directed Empire to file revised tariff sheets to add the map and legal description of the exclusive territory it obtained from the Fifth Territorial Agreement between White River Valley Electric Cooperative and The Empire District Electric Company, as amended by the First Amendment to the Fifth Territorial Agreement, to those it has from prior Commission approved territorial agreements. On February 6, Empire filed its revised tariff sheets.

The Commission will require its Staff to file a recommendation advising the Commission whether the revised tariff sheets are in compliance with the Commission's January 11 Report and Order.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation advising the Commission whether The Empire District Electric Company's revised tariff sheets, filed on February 6, 2007, are in compliance with the Commission's January 11, 2007 Report and Order approving the territorial agreement.
2. The Staff of the Commission shall file the pleading described in ordered paragraph 1 no later than February 28, 2007.
3. This order shall become effective on February 6, 2007.
