On February 5, 2007, Aquila Inc., d/b/a Aquila Networks – MPS and Aquila Networks – L&P, filed its Utility Resource Filing as required by 4 CSR 240-22. This filing is also sometimes known as an integrated resource plan, or IRP.

On November 1, 2007, Aquila, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, and Dogwood Energy, LLC, filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement that purports to resolve all alleged deficiencies in the filing. The City of Kansas City, Missouri, the City of Saint Joseph, Missouri and Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association did not sign the stipulation and agreement. However, Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.115 provides that if no party objects to a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement within seven days of its filing, the stipulation and agreement may be treated as unanimous. No party has objected. Therefore, the stipulation and agreement will be treated as if it were unanimous.

The Commission has questions about the stipulation and agreement, and will schedule an on-the-record presentation for parties to answer those questions. The Commissions' questions may cover, but not be limited to, the following topics:

Load growth and plans to meet that growth

Generation portfolio

Demand side management

Demand response

Combined heat and power and cogeneration issues

Efforts to prepare for climate change and new federal climate policy
