## **ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION**

On June 15, 2007, Interstate Power and Light Company (IPL), f/k/a IES Utilities, Inc., and ITC Midwest LLC (ITC) asked the Commission to transfer a certificate of convenience and necessity from IPL to ITC. The applicants ask that the Commission approve this application no later than September 1, 2007.

On July 9, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed an application to intervene. AmerenUE states that it has interconnections and a Joint Use Agreement with IPL, and states that its interest is therefore different from that of the general public, and cannot be adequately represented by another party.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No parties timely responded to this application. Therefore, the Commission will take it up unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed application, the-Commission finds that the applicant meets the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the above-mentioned application to intervene.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application of Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE to Intervene is

granted.

2. This order shall become effective on July 23, 2007.
