APPLICATION OF MIDWEST INDEPENDENT TRANSMISSION SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC. TO INTERVENE

The Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. ("Midwest ISO"), by and through its counsel and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075, applies to intervene in the above-entitled matter. In support of its Application, the Midwest ISO states:

1. The Midwest ISO is a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under the laws of Delaware, with its principal office at 701 City Center Drive, Carmel, Indiana 46032.

2. The Midwest ISO is a regional transmission organization (RTO) that monitors and controls the bulk electric system for its transmission owner members and system users, and provides all customers with open access transmission service. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approved the Midwest ISO as the nation's first RTO on December 20, 2001. On February 1, 2002, the Midwest ISO began providing regional transmission service for the movement of bulk power over the facilities in the Midwest ISO footprint.

4. On June 20, 2003, Aquila, Inc. ("Aquila") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission for approval to transfer operational control over certain designated transmission facilities to the Midwest ISO pursuant to Section 393.190.1, Mo. Rev. Stat. (2000).

5. The Midwest ISO requests leave to intervene in the above-entitled matter.

6. The Midwest ISO supports the application of Aquila which is a transmission owner member of Midwest ISO. Aquila does not currently take full network service from Midwest ISO as it is not yet directly connected to the Midwest ISO system. Because Midwest ISO will exercise functional operational control over certain transmission assets of Aquila if the application is granted, its interest in this proceeding is different from that of the general public and cannot be adequately represented by any other party.

7. Midwest ISO's participation in this matter will not delay or hinder these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Midwest ISO respectfully requests permission to intervene in support of the above-entitled matter.
