On March 2, 2005, Aquila, Inc., asked the Commission to approve its experimental regulatory plan. Aquila has twice amended its application, and now asks only for authority to encumber certain assets to participate in upgrading latan 1 and building latan 2.

On July 15, Staff informed the Commission that a stipulation was imminent, and asked the Commission to set the matter for hearing as early as circumstances permit. On July 18, the parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement.

The Commission will grant Staff's request, and set a hearing for August 1-2 for counsel to answer the Commission's questions. The Commission will also reserve the right to receive evidence.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That a hearing will be held on August 1, 2005, beginning at 8:30 a.m., and will resume on August 2, 2005, at 1:00 p.m., in Room 310 of the Commission's offices at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
