ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND ORDER
EXTENDING DEADLINE FOR ALL PARTIES TO RESPOND TO STAFF
SUGGESTIONS IN SUPPORT OF STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

On March 28, 2005, Kansas City Power & Light Company and other parties filed a Stipulation and Agreement. That agreement involved KCPL's proposed experimental regulatory plan for, among other things, building latan Unit 2.

On May 10, the Staff of the Commission filed Suggestions in Support of the Stipulation and Agreement. The Commission ordered parties to respond to those suggestions no later than May 20.

On May 19, the Office of the Public Counsel filed its Motion for Extension of Time to File Suggestions and Motion for Expedited Treatment. OPC explained that its attorney had been suddenly terminated on May 16, and that new counsel has not had enough time to prepare a response. OPC asks for an additional week, until May 27, to file a response. KCPL does not object. The U.S. Department of Energy and Praxair, Inc., also do not object, and ask for a similar extension of time.

The Commission finds OPC's request reasonable, and will grant it. The Commission will also give other parties the same additional week to respond.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Office of the Public Counsel's Motion for Extension of Time to File Suggestions and Motion for Expedited Treatment is granted.
2. That the Office of the Public Counsel may respond to the Staff Suggestions in Support of Stipulation and Agreement no later than May 27, 2005.
3. That all other parties may also respond to the Staff Suggestions in Support of Stipulation and Agreement no later than May 27, 2005.
4. That this order shall become effective on May 20, 2005.
