**ORDER SUSPENDING REQUIREMENT TO SUBMIT PROCEDURAL**  
**SCHEDULE**

On June 27, 2006, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, (“AmerenUE”) filed an application requesting that the Commission grant it a variance from 4 CSR 240-20.050 and its tariff Section II.K Non-Standard Service of the Company’s Schedule 5 – Schedule of Rates for Electrical Service. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.050(5) allows for variances from individual electric metering requirements upon a showing of good cause.

On September 19, 2006, a prehearing conference was held and the parties indicated that a resolution to this matter may be forthcoming. Following the prehearing, the Commission granted Staff’s unopposed request to modify the deadline for filing the procedural schedule to alternatively allow for the filing of a status report should additional time be required for negotiations.

On September 26, 2006, the parties jointly filed a status report. The parties indicate that they are preparing a stipulation of facts to facilitate the presentation of their resolution of this matter, and they request that the requirement of filing a procedural

schedule be indefinitely suspended. Because the parties indicate that a resolution is forthcoming, the Commission finds their request to be reasonable. Consequently, the Commission will grant the parties' request.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The requirement for filing a procedural schedule for this case is indefinitely suspended.
2. The parties shall file the stipulation of facts as to the resolution of this matter, or a status report, no later than October 27, 2006.
3. This order shall become effective on September 27, 2006.
