On November 27, 2012, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to grant it a variance from a provision of the Commission's IRP rule to allow the company to file its next triennial compliance report on October 1, 2014, rather than on April 1, 2014, as would be required by the rule. The Commission will establish a time for interested parties to respond to Ameren Missouri's motion.

Ameren Missouri's motion represented that it was served on all parties to Ameren Missouri's previous Triennial Compliance Filing case, EO-2011-0271. The Commission will direct its Data Center to add those parties to this case so that all such parties will receive notice of filings in this case.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties to File No. EO-2011-0271 as parties to this case.
- 2. Any party wishing to respond to Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Request for Variance from 4 CSR 240-22.080(1)(C) shall do so no later than December 13, 2012.
