**ORDER GRANTING VARIANCE**

On April 11, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO") asked the Commission to grant it a variance from the Commission rule setting the deadline on which Ameren Missouri must file its Renewable Energy Standard ("RES") plan. That rule is Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(7)(B)1F. And the deadline from that rule is April 15.

GMO asks the Commission to extend the date for filing its RES plan to May 28, 2013. GMO states that it needs the extra time to ensure a calculation required in the report comports with a recent court opinion, as well as the RES statute and regulations.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4) permits applications for variances from Commission Rules. Such an application shall set out a "complete justification setting out the good cause for granting the variance."

Based upon KCP&L's pleading, the Commission finds good cause to grant the requested variance.


**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Application for Variance is granted.

2. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file its Renewable Energy Standard (RES) Compliance Plan no later than May 28, 2013.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
