ORDER DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION

On June 26, 2013, the Commission issued an order granting Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri a variance from the Commission’s Utility Promotional Practices Rule, 4 CSR 240-14, to allow Ameren Missouri to offer the developer of a subdivision the installation of underground electric facilities at no cost to the developer. On July 2, Ameren Missouri issued a tariff that implements the Commission’s order by including the recently granted variance in a list of previously granted variances. Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to expedite its approval of the tariff revision so that it can go into effect on July 5.


The Commission will direct its Staff to offer an expedited recommendation regarding the tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation regarding Ameren Missouri’s compliance tariff no later than 1:00 p.m. on July 3, 2013.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
