ORDER DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION AND ESTABLISHING TIME TO INTERVENE OR TO OBJECT TO TARIFF

On July 29, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") asked the Commission to grant it a variance from certain portions of the Commission's Net Metering rules in 4 CSR 240-20.065 and the Commission's Electric Utility Renewable Standard Requirements in 4 CSR 240-20.100. Ameren Missouri also submitted modified tariffs: Rider SR – Solar Rebate and Rider SP – SREC Purchase and Electric Power Purchases from Qualified Net Metering Units.

The Missouri Legislature's House Bill No. 142 becomes effective on August 28, 2013, and will revise statutes in the Missouri Renewable Energy Standard. Ameren Missouri is requesting a variance from portions of the Commission's current rules concerning solar rebates and ownership of Renewable Energy Credits, which Ameren Missouri states will conflict with the revised statutes. Ameren Missouri seeks the Commission's approval of its modified tariffs to reflect the new legislation.

The Commission will order a Staff Recommendation and will establish a time to apply to intervene or to object to tariff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than August 14, 2013 regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Request for Approval of Tariff and For Variance.

2. Any motion to intervene or asking the Commission to suspend or reject Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's revised Rider SR-Solar Rebate or Rider SP- SREC Purchase and Electric Power Purchases from Qualified Net Metering Units tariffs must be filed no later than August 14, 2013.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
