

Dear Spring Branch Water Customer:

This is to inform you that Foxfire Utility Company has filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) seeking the Commission's approval for Foxfire to donate the Spring Branch water system to The Upper White River Basin Foundation. The Upper White River Basin Foundation would immediately transfer the system to Ozarks Clean Water Company (OCWC) which would then own and operate the system on a going forward basis.

OCWC is a membership based not-for-profit water and sewer company formed under Missouri State Statutes and, as such, is not subject to PSC jurisdiction. It is governed by a board of directors elected from the membership of the company. Every customer is a member of the company and is entitled to vote for directors.

OCWC is based in Kimberling City, Missouri. It presently serves approximately 1,200 individual connections for sewer service and approximately 115 individual connections for water service. Ozarks Clean Water Company has been in existence since 2004 and has previously accepted three sewer companies and one water company that were formerly regulated by the Commission.

There are no expected rate changes initially. OCWC will retain the current rate structure for at least six months and until it has sufficient experience to determine whether and what changes in rates may be needed.
