## **ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This case has been remanded to the Commission from the Western District Court of Appeals. The parties met in a prehearing conference on August 10, 2010, and jointly filed a proposed procedural schedule on August 12, 2010. The schedule consists of dates for briefs and reply briefs on the meaning of the Court's Opinion and the implications of that decision, and a date for oral argument. The parties noted that depending on the Commission's decision on the threshold legal matters raised by the parties in their pleadings, it may be necessary to establish additional proceedings, including evidentiary hearings, to consider any factual issues that may arise.

The Commission has considered the parties' motion and will adopt the schedule proposed. The Commission may schedule further proceedings in a later order.

- 2. The following procedural schedule is established:

Parties file initial pleadings/ briefs on the August 31, 2010 meaning of the Court of Appeals Opinion and the implications of that decision

Parties file reply pleadings / briefs in September 10, 2010 response to initial pleadings

Oral argument

September 20, 2010 beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Oral argument will be held at the Commission's office in the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Room 310, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
