## ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY

Issue Date: December 21, 2010 Effective Date: December 21, 2010 The procedural schedule for this case requires all parties to file surrebuttal and cross-surrebuttal testimony on December 22, 2010. On December 21, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion requesting a brief extension of time to file that testimony.

Ameren Missouri explains that the Commission's electronic filing system – EFIS – will be unavailable on the evening of December 22 due to scheduled network maintenance. Ameren Missouri is concerned that the unavailability of EFIS could interfere with its efforts to file testimony. For that reason, Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to extend the deadline for all parties to file testimony until 9:00 a.m. on December 23. Ameren Missouri represents that no party opposes the requested extension.

Ameren Missouri's motion is reasonable and the Commission will grant the requested extension.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The deadline for filing surrebuttal and cross-surrebuttal testimony is extended from December 22, 2010, until December 23, 2010, at 9:00 a.m.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
