The Commission will grant the request for confidential treatment.

As to the financial information and notice of compliance, the Commission will order Staff to respond as follows.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than June 25, 2009, the Commission's staff ("Staff") shall file a response to the notice that Broadvox-CLEC, LLC, ("Broadvox") filed on June 11, 2009.
- 2. The response in ordered paragraph 1 shall state whether the financial information that Broadvox filed on June 11, 2009 shows compliance with 4 CSR 240-3.510(1).
- 3. If Staff's response states that Broadvox has shown compliance with with 4 CSR 240-3.510(1), Staff shall file a revised recommendation no later than July 9, 2009.
- 4. The motion for confidential treatment that Broadvox filed on June 11, 2009 is granted.
  - 5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
