To match the treatment of revenues and expenses from the test year used to set the rates. This means that if there were non-Missouri retail jurisdictional revenues during that period we do not use those to calculate the revenue requirement for the Missouri retail jurisdiction in the rate case, and similarly, if there were expenses related to producing the non-Missouri retail jurisdictional revenues during that period we do not use those expenses to calculate the revenue requirement.
