**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

**COMES NOW**, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and for its *Motion for Extension of Time* states as follows:

1. On October 21, 2011, Mr. Travis Miller (“Mr. Miller” or “Applicant”), filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) an *Application* seeking approval to change the electric supplier to his property from Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) to Ozark Border Electric Company (“Ozark”).

2. On October 24, 2011, the Commission ordered Staff to file a recommendation by December 5, 2011.

3. Staff is currently investigating the implications of the proposed transaction, and is unable to file a recommendation at this time. The parties to this case will be having discussions over the next several weeks which should provide Staff the information necessary to formulate its’ recommendation.

4. Staff anticipates it will be in position to file a recommendation by January 17, 2012.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff requests that the Commission, for the reasons contained herein, grant the Staff leave to file its recommendation by January 17, 2012.
