PROPOSED LIST OF ISSUES, ORDER OF WITNESSES AND ORDER OF CROSS

Therefore, Aquila requests, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.025, that, for good cause, the Commission waive the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.080(21).
 - 3. The parties have assembled the following statement of the issues to be heard, order

of issues, list of witnesses, order of witnesses and order of cross-examination. The listing of issues below is not to be considered as an agreement by any party that any particular listed issue is, in fact, a valid or relevant issue. Indeed, in the subsequent filing of position statements, some parties may state that they consider a particular listed issue to not be, or no longer be, a valid issue. This "non-binding" listing of issues is not to be construed as impairing any party's ability to argue about any of these issues or related matters, or to restrict the scope of its response to arguments made by other parties.
