## ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO FILE A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On August 20, 2014, the Commission indefinitely stayed the previously-established procedural schedule to allow the parties more time to negotiate a possible settlement. Staff and Ameren Missouri filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement on September 19, but Public Counsel objected to that stipulation and agreement on September 26 and requests a hearing. The Commission will direct the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 1, 2014.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
