ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S MOTION TO EXCLUDE PORTIONS OF STAFF'S AND AMEREN MISSOURI'S DIRECT TESTMONY

On October 29, 2014, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to strike portions of the direct testimony filed by Staff's and Ameren Missouri's witnesses. By Commission rule, the other parties are allowed ten days to respond to Public Counsel's motion, unless the Commission establishes some other date for response.¹

The procedural schedule for this case requires the parties to file rebuttal testimony by November 17. If the parties are to know what direct testimony they must rebut, the Commission will need to rule on Public Counsel's motion no later than its agenda meeting of November 12. The ten-day rule would make responses due by Saturday, November 8. Since that is a weekend, responses would actually be due the following Monday, November 10. That would not allow the Commission sufficient time to consider any response before its November 12 agenda meeting. For that reason, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for responding to Public Counsel's motion to Wednesday, November 5.
