**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION TO FILE LIST OF ISSUES AND
STATEMENT OF POSITIONS**

Issue Date: May 11, 2012

Effective Date: May 11, 2012

The procedural schedule for this case requires the parties to file a list of issues, order of witnesses, order of cross-examination, and order of opening by May 10, 2012. That schedule further requires the parties to file statements of position by May 15. The procedural schedule leads to a hearing beginning on May 23.

On May 10, the Commission's Staff, acting on behalf of all the other parties, filed a motion asking that the Commission extend the date to file the list of issues until May 15, with the statements of position to be filed on May 18. Staff's motion explains that the parties need additional time to finalize and agree upon the required documents.

The Commission is willing to allow the parties additional time to complete and file the documents. However, the parties must keep in mind that the Commissioners, the presiding officer, and their support staff rely on those documents to prepare for the hearing. The Commission will allow the parties until May 15 to file their list of issues, and until May 18 to file their statements of position, but will require the parties to file their statements of position by 1:00 p.m. on the 18th so that those documents will be available for review before the end of the business week.
