## PUBLIC COUNSEL'S SUPPLEMENT TO ITS MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") and submits this supplement to its motion for extension of time to file its statement of positions and the corrected testimony of Dr. Geoff Marke:

- 1. On December 30, 2014, Public Counsel filed a motion for a one day extension of time to file both its statement of positions and corrections to the pre-filed testimony of Public Counsel's expert Dr. Marke.<sup>1</sup> The extension of time is necessary to remedy certain late discovered methodological errors, the resolution of which will ensure that the Commission is provided with complete and accurate information. Within that filing, Public Counsel stated that because of the late discovery of the error, it was unable to seek input from the other parties in this case and would file this supplement as soon as it was able to reach the parties.
- 2. Counsel for the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri have communicated to Public Counsel that their respective clients do not object to the extension of time for Public Counsel to file its position statements and its corrections to the pre-filed testimony of Dr. Marke.
