ORDER DIRECTING JOINT PROPOSED SCHEDULE

On June 30, 2020, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation following its second prudence review of Cycle 2 costs related to the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act for the period April 1, 2018 through December 31, 2019. Staff identified and recommended certain disallowances or adjustments. On July 7, 2020, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (Evergy West) disputed Staffs disallowances and requested a hearing. Evergy West requested the prompt setting of a prehearing conference to develop a procedural schedule.

In order to expedite the development of a procedural schedule, and in light of the current social distancing restrictions, the Commission will direct the parties to jointly propose a procedural schedule for pre-filed testimony and an evidentiary hearing, or for briefing and oral argument.

The Commission requests the parties include the following as part of the procedural schedule:

- Submission of a Joint Stipulation of Facts;
- Submission of List of Issues and Order of Hearing Components, and Position Statements at least one week in advance of the hearing;

- An evidentiary hearing held via WebEx; and
- Ten days for transcript turnaround for briefing schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than July 22, 2020, the parties shall submit a joint proposed procedural schedule as described in the body of this order.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
