ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND

On September 27, 2020, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2020 triennial integrated resource planning (IRP) compliance filing. Several stakeholders responded to that filing on March 31, 2021. By rule, Ameren Missouri has sixty days to respond to the stakeholder filings, meaning the company's response would be due by May 28. On May 27, the Commission granted Ameren Missouri's motion to extend that filing date until June 11. On June 11, Ameren Missouri again requested that the filing deadline be extended, this time until June 18, to allow more time for discussions with stakeholders. The motion represents that Ameren Missouri has contacted all parties and none oppose the requested extension. Based on the motion's representation, the Commission will treat the requested extension as unopposed.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-22.080(15) allows the Commission to modify the response periods regarding the IRP filing for good cause shown. The Commission finds that good cause has been shown to extend the time to respond.
