SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPORT

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, through counsel,
and states as follows:

1. On March 19, 2021 Barrel 53 Cooperage (“Barrel 53”) submitted its application to change its electric supplier from Howard Electric Cooperative to Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren.

2. On March 22 the Commission ordered Howard Electric and Ameren to respond to Barrel 53’s application by April 21 and Staff to file a report by May 6.

3. On April 26 Staff requested additional time to May 27 to file its recommendation in order to receive and incorporate Howard Electric’s and Ameren’s data request responses in its report.

4. On April 26 the Commission granted Staff’s motion and ordered that Staff’s report would be due May 27.

5. Barrel 53 and Howard Electric are involved in negotiations. Staff requests a second extension of time to June 11 to file its report. The additional time is requested to allow negotiations to continue and if they are unsuccessful, to give Staff sufficient time to prepare its report.

6. Counsel spoke with Christopher Pieper, Barrel 53 counsel. Counsel also exchanged emails with Andrew Sporleder, Howard Electric counsel and Eric Banks, Ameren counsel. All parties stated that they do not oppose this request.

WHEREFORE, Staff requests that the Commission grant it an extension of time to June 11, 2021 to file its report.
