ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS

On July 5, 2006, Kansas City Power & Light Company filed its Application for Extensions of Time and Waivers Concerning Certain of the Commission's Integrated Resource Plan Reporting Requirements. The Integrated Resource Plan is required by 4 CSR 240-22. On July 25, 2006, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, and on August 3, 2006, Praxair, Inc., filed applications to intervene. No responses to the applications to intervene have been filed.

The MDNR states that it is a state agency vested with the powers and duties set forth in Section 640.250, RSMo. Specifically, MDNR states that it has an interest which is different from that of the general public because its Energy Center will be reviewing the filing from a formal policy and planning perspective as well as looking at the environmental quality issues as mandated by Section 640.250, RSMo.

Praxair states that it is a large industrial electric customer and was a party to the recently concluded regulatory plan case, EO-2005-0263. Praxair also states that its interest is different from that of the general public because of its size and load factor.

The Commission has discretion to permit an applicant to intervene if the applicant "shows that it has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case or that granting the intervention would serve the public interest." The Commission finds that MDNR and Praxair each have an interest that is different from that of the general public, and that allowing the interventions will serve the public interest. The Commission shall grant the applications to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources is granted intervention in this case.
 - 2. Praxair, Inc., is granted intervention in this case.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on August 8, 2006.
