ORDER SUSPENDING REQUIREMENT TO SUBMIT PROCEDURAL
SCHEDULE

On January 2, 2007,¹ Callaway Electric Cooperative and the City of Fulton, Missouri filed a joint application requesting that the Commission make a determination that their proposed territorial agreement was not detrimental to the public interest. On January 3, the Commission directed notice, set an intervention deadline, set a time for staff to file its recommendation, and set a date for the filing of a procedural schedule, should any party request a hearing. The deadline for the filing of the procedural schedule, culminating in a hearing to take place on or before March 5, was set for February 12.

No requests for intervention were filed, and on February 1, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed its recommendation and memorandum supporting approval of the territorial agreement. The parties have been given until February 13 to file responses to Staff's recommendation.

¹ All dates throughout this order refer to the year 2007 unless otherwise noted.

To date, no party has requested a hearing. However, should a party object to Staff's recommendation and request a hearing then a procedural schedule would be required. Because the parties have been given until February 13 to respond to Staff's recommendation, the original deadline for the filing of a procedural schedule must be suspended. If no party requests a hearing by February 13, then the requirement for a procedural schedule will be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The requirement for filing a procedural schedule for this case on or before February 12, 2007, is indefinitely suspended.
2. In the event that no party requests a hearing on or before February 13, then the requirement for the filing of a procedural schedule is canceled.
3. This order shall become effective on February 6, 2007.
