ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF
INTERVENTION REQUESTS, AND SCHEDULING A CONFERENCE

On February 5, 2008, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE filed its 2008 Integrated Resource Planning Filing (IRP), which is required by the Commission's Integrated Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. The purpose of the IRP filing is to ensure that investor-owned electric utilities, such as AmerenUE, consider all options, including demand side efficiency and energy management measures, so as to provide safe, reliable and efficient electric service to the public at reasonable rates, in a manner that serves the public interest.

As required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(4), the Commission will give notice of AmerenUE's filing to potentially interested parties, will set a date for the filing of requests to intervene, and will schedule a conference. The Commission has previously added several parties to this case and those parties do not need to again ask to intervene.¹

¹ Those parties are: the Missouri Department of Natural Resources; the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers; the Sierra Club, Missouri Coalition for the Environment, Mid-Missouri Peaceworks and the Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now; the Missouri Energy Group; Noranda Aluminum; and Aquila, Inc.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's service area.

2. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than February 27, 2008. Such applications shall be filed with:
