**ORDER GRANTING THE MISSOURI JOINT MUNICIPAL ELECTRICAL
UTILITY COMMISSION'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE**

On February 27, 2008, the Missouri Joint Municipal Electrical Utility Commission (MJMEUC) filed an application to intervene in this case, in which the Commission is considering Union Electric Company's 2008 Integrated Resource Plan. MJMEUC serves various municipalities that have wholesale power contracts with Union Electric or otherwise take electricity through that company's transmission system. No party has objected to MJMEUC's application to intervene.

The Commission finds that the interest of MJMEUC in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MJMEUC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Missouri Joint Municipal Electrical Utility Commission's Application to Intervene is granted.

2. This order shall become effective on March 7, 2008.
