On July 5, 2012<sup>1</sup>, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed a Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and a Motion for Expedited Treatment. Contemporaneously therewith, GMO extended the tariff sheets that would implement a Demand Side Investment Mechanism ("DSIM") until September 17. The Commission granted the motions on July 5, due to GMO noting no objections to the motions.

The Commission has received no further pleadings from the parties since the July 5 motions. Unless the tariff sheets' effective dates are extended by GMO or suspended by the Commission, the tariff sheets will become effective September 17. Thus, the Commission will allow the parties to inform the Commission whether they object to the tariff sheets going into effect. In the alternative, GMO may voluntarily extend the effective date of the tariff sheets.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall file pleadings as listed above no later than September 14, 2012, at 12:00 p.m.
