The Commission is ordering notice of this action to Ozark Border Electric Co-Operative and AmerenUE (“respondents”) and directing responsive pleadings as follows. As to each allegation in the application, each respondent shall file an answer. Each answer shall:

- Admit, deny, or state that the respondent is without sufficient knowledge to admit or deny; and
- Set forth authority and allegations that support respondent's position on the application.

The Commission will also order its staff to file a recommendation on the application.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall deliver this notice and order, with a copy of the application, on Ozark Border Electric Co-Operative and AmerenUE.
2. No later than November 23, 2011, Ozark Border Electric Co-Operative shall file an answer as directed in the body of this order.
3. No later than November 23, 2011, AmerenUE shall file an answer as directed in the body of this order.

4. No later than December 5, 2011, the Commission's staff shall file a recommendation on the application.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
