On September 2, 2016, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and the Staff of the Commission filed a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement to address Ameren Missouri's performance incentive award under the company's Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA) Cycle 1 programs. Public Counsel objected to that stipulation and agreement on September 9. As a result, the Commission will need to take evidence regarding the proper calculation of the performance incentive award.

On September 23, Ameren Missouri, Staff, Public Counsel, and the Division of Energy jointly filed a proposed procedural schedule. That proposed schedule will lead to a hearing on October 24. Ameren Missouri requests that the Commission issue its order by November 23, so that the awarded performance incentive can be included in Ameren Missouri's annual Energy Efficiency Investment Charge tariff that it intends to file in November.

The Commission will adopt the procedural schedule proposed by the parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

- 2. The parties shall comply with the following procedural requirements:
- (A) Testimony shall be prefiled as defined in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.130. All parties must comply with this rule, including the requirement that testimony be filed on line-numbered pages.
- (B) The parties shall agree upon and Staff shall file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, the order in which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The list of issues should be detailed enough to inform the Commission of each issue that must be resolved. The Commission will view any issue not contained in this list of issues as uncontested and not requiring resolution by the Commission.

- (C) Each party shall file a simple and concise statement summarizing its position on each disputed issue.
- (D) All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080. Briefs shall follow the same list of issues as filed in the case and must set forth and cite the proper portions of the record concerning the remaining unresolved issues that are to be decided by the Commission.
- (E) All parties shall bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend to offer into evidence at the hearing. If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it must bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners, the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

3. The hearing will be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
