ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO FILE A STATUS REPORT

On June 5, 2015, Ameren Missouri filed an Application for Approval of Change Request seeking Commission approval of a correction to the Final EM&V reports prepared by ADM Associates, Inc. and Cadmus, and filed by Ameren Missouri on May 15. Ameren Missouri seeks to correct a portion of the report that it believes is incorrect due to a calculation error.

On June 12, Ameren Missouri filed a status report indicating that it had a telephone conference with Staff and Public Counsel on June 9, at which Ameren Missouri agreed to provide workpapers and support for correction of the identified errors, to coordinate correction of the errors with the evaluator, and to continue to cooperate with Staff and Public Counsel. The status report advised the Commission that Staff intended to review Ameren Missouri's proposed correction and would "communicate" its agreement or disagreement with the corrections. The status report also noted that objections to the change request were to be filed by June 26, but did not propose any further procedural schedule for consideration of that change request.

No party has filed an objection to Ameren Missouri's change request, but no party has indicated agreement with Ameren Missouri's change request either. Furthermore, Ameren Missouri filed revised EM&V reports on June 23, but it is not clear whether the revised reports incorporate the changes requested by Ameren Missouri. As a result, it is unclear what, if any, further action by the Commission is required. Therefore, the Commission will direct the parties to file a status report advising of any further required action by the Commission

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than July 16, 2015, the parties shall file a status report advising of any further required Commission action.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
