**ORDER REGARDING 2017 RES  
COMPLIANCE REPORT AND GRANTING WAIVER**

Effective Date: June 30, 2018

On April 13, 2018, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") filed its Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report for 2017 ("Report"), as it was required to do by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8). KCP&L amended the Report on May 22, 2018. The Commission's rule requires the Staff of the Commission to review the utility's report and to file a report about its review within 45 days.<sup>1</sup>

Staff filed a pleading on the Report on May 25, 2018. Staff reported no deficiencies in the Report.

The Commission's rule also allows Public Counsel and other interested persons or entities to file comments regarding KCP&L's Report.<sup>2</sup> The Division of Energy stated that the recent passage of Senate Bill 564 may warrant altering methods of compliance and revisions to the Report. KCP&L responded on June 8, 2018, stating that Senate Bill 564 does not change the requirements of the Commission's rules or the enabling statutes that require the Report. No other comments were filed.

The Commission's regulation does not specify what, if any, action the Commission is to take regarding KCP&L's Report and any alleged deficiencies in that Report, except to allow the Commission to direct the utility to provide additional information or to address any concerns or deficiencies identified in the comments.<sup>3</sup> After considering the submitted comments, the Commission concludes that no further order from the Commission is appropriate at this time regarding the RES Report.

The Commission, however, will grant KCP&L the limited waiver of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8)(A)1.I.(V) it requested because meter reading information is not provided by the vendors from which KCP&L purchases Renewable Energy Credits. Staff recommends the Commission grant this waiver.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company will not be required to provide additional information or to address any concerns or deficiencies.
2. Kansas City Power & Light Company is granted a limited waiver from Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8)(A)1.I.(V) as recommended by Staff.
3. This order shall be effective on June 30, 2018.
4. This file shall be closed on July 1, 2018.


