# ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ACKNOWLEDGING AUTOMATIC PARTIES, AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINES FOR INTERVENTION AND REQUESTING A HEARING

Issue Date: September 11, 2018 Effective Date: September 11, 2018

On September 7, 2018, the Commission's Staff filed notice that on September 4, 2018, it started its prudence audit of the fuel adjustment clause (FAC) established for KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) for the period December 1, 2016, through May 31, 2018. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(7)(B) requires Staff to file notice regarding the commencement of an audit. That rule also requires Staff to file its recommendation regarding the audit no later than 180 days after it initiates the audit. Pursuant to the same rule, other parties to the case have 190 days after initiation of the audit to request a hearing.

The Commission will give notice of the commencement of Staff's audit to potentially interested persons and entities and will set a date for the filing of applications to intervene. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240.3.161(10)(A) provides that parties to the general rate case in which the Commission approved a rate adjustment mechanism (RAM) are automatically parties to this prudence audit case.<sup>1</sup> In general rate Case No.

ER-2016-0156, the Commission approved GMO substitute tariff sheets to take effect on February 22, 2017. Parties to that case will automatically be parties to this prudence audit case. Additionally, the Staff will identify and file the names of all other entities or persons who must be made parties per Rule 4 CSR 240.3.161(10)(A).

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Staff Counsel shall identify and file the names of all persons and entities described in 4 CSR 240.3.161(10)(A) who must be made parties to this case, no later than September 25, 2018.
- 2. The Commission's Data Center shall add the parties from File Number ER-2016-0156 and those identified by Staff to the certified service list for this file.
- 3. Applications to intervene shall be filed no later than October 10, 2018. Such applications shall be filed by using the Commission's electronic filing and information system or by delivery to:

- 4. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than March 3, 2019.
- 5. Any request for a hearing shall be filed no later than March 13, 2019.
