ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) has filed an application asking the Commission to approve a special incremental load rate for a steel production facility in Sedalia, Missouri. The procedural schedule established to consider that application provided that rebuttal testimony was to be filed by the parties on August 27, 2019. On August 26, the Commission, at the request of the parties, extended that filing date until August 30.

On August 29, GMO and Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to modify the remainder of the procedural schedule including the hearing date. Because rebuttal testimony is currently due on August 30, the Commission directed that any other party wishing to respond to the motion do so by 9:00 a.m. on August 30. Public Counsel responded on August 29, indicating it does not oppose the revised procedural schedule. No other party responded.

The Commission finds the revised procedural schedule proposed by GMO and Staff to be reasonable and will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule is granted.
2. The procedural schedule is modified to provide:

- Rebuttal Testimony - September 9, 2019
- Surrebuttal Testimony - September 30, 2019
- List of Issues, Order of Witnesses, etc. - October 2, 2019
- Statements of Position - October 4, 2019
- Hearing - October 17 and 18, 2019
Beginning Each Day at 9:00 a.m.
- Initial Briefs - November 1, 2019
- Reply Briefs - November 8, 2019

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
