ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On September 11, 2019, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an Amended Report and Order effective September 21, 2019, regarding approval of a transaction in which Invenergy Transmission LLC would acquire ownership of Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC. On September 12, 2019, the Eastern Missouri Landowners Alliance d/b/a Show Me Concerned Landowners, and Joseph and Rose Kroner, filed an application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2016, states that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if “in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear.” In the judgment of the Commission, the Eastern Missouri Landowners Alliance d/b/a Show Me Concerned Landowners, and Joseph and Rose Kroner’s application for rehearing does not demonstrate sufficient reason to rehear the matter. The Commission will deny the application for rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Eastern Missouri Landowners Alliance d/b/a Show Me Concerned Landowners, and Joseph and Rose Kroner's application for rehearing is denied.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
