JOINT PROPOSED DATES FOR IN-PERSON HEARING

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, on behalf of itself, Barbara Edwards (“Complainant”), and Evergy Missouri West, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (“Respondent”)(collectively “Parties”), and for the Parties’ *Joint Proposed Dates for In-Person Hearing*, state as follows:
